<b>Recommended Kitten Plan</b>		
<b>6 - 8 weeks old</b>	Start vaccinations, vaccinate for upper respiratory disease (FVRCP) every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks	
<b>8 weeks old</b>	<b>FIV/Leukemia Test</b>	If positive: isolate and re-test @ 6m
<b>(2 months)</b>	<b>FVRCP#1</b>	Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis - Calicivirus - Panleukopenia
	<b>Parasite</b>	Deworm for most common parasites with pyrantel (+ praziquantel if fleas or tapeworms seen)
	<b>Treatment &amp; Prevention</b>	Start applying Frontline or Revolution monthly for flea prevention Check for ear mites - treat with Accarex or start Revolution (tx every 2w x 2 doses, then q4w) Send in fecal test / Giardia ELISA - additional deworming as indicated by results
<b>12 weeks old</b>	<b>FVRCP#2</b>	
<b>(3 months)</b>	<b>Leukemia #1</b>	Necessary if: kitten will be outdoors anytime, exposed to any other cats going outdoors or will have exposure to feral cats Not Necessary if: indoor only, no exposure to any cats that go outdoors
<b>16 weeks old</b>	<b>Rabies 1y</b>	Boost in 1y (1y, 4m old), then every 1 or 3 years (depending on vaccine used) ALWAYS
<b>(4 months)</b>	<b>FVRCP#3</b>	Boost in 1y (1y, 4m old), then every 1-3 years (depending on vaccine used)
	<b>Leukemia #2</b>	Boost in 1y (1y, 4m old), then every 1 year
<b>16 - 24 weeks old</b>	<b>Spay or neuter</b>	Spay or neuter BEFORE allowing kitten to go outside
<b>(4 - 6 months)</b>		**pain control medications and E-collar strongly recommended

<b>Animals 6 months or older, animals with unknown history</b>		
<b>FIV/Leukemia test</b>	Always recommended for animals not previously tested Recommend at-risk cats be tested every 1 year	
<b>Parasite</b>	Deworm for most common parasites with pyrantel and praziquantel	
<b>Treatment &amp; Prevention</b>	Start applying Frontline or Revolution monthly for flea prevention Check for ear mites - treat with Accarex or start Revolution (q2w x 2 doses, then monthly) Send in fecal test / Giardia ELISA - additional deworming as indicated by results	
<b>Rabies 1y</b>	Boost in 1y, then every 1 or 3 years (depending on vaccine used) ALWAYS	
<b>FVRCP</b>	2 doses given 1 month apart, then boost every 1-3 years (depending on vaccine used)	
<b>Leukemia</b>	If Necessary (see above): 2 doses given 1 month apart, then boost every 1-3 years (depending on vaccine used)	
<b>Spay or neuter</b>	Spay or neuter BEFORE allowing kitten / cat to go back outside **pain control medications and E-collar strongly recommended
